Who are the Friends?

The Friends of the Hamilton East Public Library is a non-profit organization that funds library programs that fall beyond the normal scope of the library budget. Funds are raised through the Fishers and Noblesville Library Book Shops, membership, and generous donations.

In 2023, the Friends of the Library helped fund various programs serving over 4,000 community members. Free public programs in 2023 included the summer reading program, Maker-in-Residence artists, two sublimation printers for the the Ignite Studio, A Taste of History: Blind Tiger Bootleggers, equipment for the Messy Munchkin program, the 10th year of the concert series, performances by Mr. Dan the Music Man, and many more.
