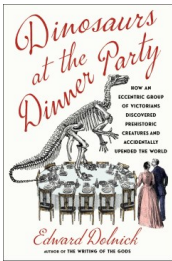


Turing Machine

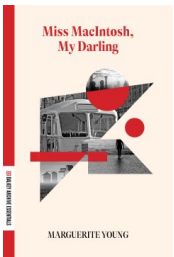


We Used to Live Here

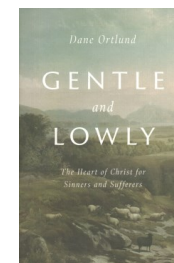
