Scope and Contents of the Materials

The Noblesville Chamber of Commerce collection contains materials created by the Noblesville Chamber of Commerce from the 1950s-2010s as well as 1917. These items have been gathered over the time by the library and have been consolidated into one collection for ease of research and use.

The collection includes:

- Brochures, pamphlets, and maps aimed to inform about Noblesville, its culture, work environment, and various facilities
- Monthly newsletters published by the Noblesville Chamber of Commerce
- Reports concerning demographics, economic reports, and tax data
- Business and Member Directories
- General items concerning local events.
- Newspapers
- Newspaper clippings concerning the Chamber and its staff and board's actions, as well as events involving or organized by the Chamber

The collection was named "Noblesville Chamber of Commerce" to facilitate discoverability. Collection materials are of interest to researchers who are likely to know about the Noblesville Chamber of Commerce or to those with an interest in local business history and economic development in Indiana.

The Noblesville Chamber of Commerce is a nonprofit organization formed in 1935 to stimulate the local economy and promote the business community of Noblesville. As an advocate for local business, the Chamber organizes events in networking, career development, community based engagement, and social activities for chamber members such as Birdies & Brews and the no longer active Corporate Challenge. Other notable programs include Taste of Business, a networking event for businesses to advertise themselves with food and displaying products and services. The Chamber focuses on supporting networks for professionals such as Women in Noblesville (WIN), Architects, Engineers, and Construction (AEC), and Young Professionals Network (YPN).

The Chamber focuses on representing the interests of Noblesville business to local governments and serving a medium between the two parties. The Chamber's "State of" series includes updates on the city, state, schools, and economy, intended to inform members on important developments. The Noblesville Chamber of Commerce is operated by staff, including president and CEO Bob DuBois as well as a board of directors, headed by Board Chair Thorpe Miller.
