Scope and Contents of the Materials

The Hamilton County Bar Association Collection contains materials acquired by Dan Pflieger relating to legal services in Hamilton County and some surrounding counties from 1908-1981.

The collection includes:

- Six pamphlets of minimum fee schedules for legal services in Hamilton, Marion, and Clinton County from 1960-1970.
 - Two binders that contain minimum fee schedules, the constitution and by-laws of the Indianapolis Bar Association, and an outline of the board of managers, officers, and committees.
 - A booklet about the accomplishments of George Arthur Frantz, the pastor, author, and teacher from 1981.
 - Two red scrapbooks that each contain newspaper clippings of various Hamilton County crimes. This includes car crashes, thefts, attacks, and Hamilton County government elections and office changes.
 - One binder with Hamilton County Bar Association meeting minutes, payment sheets, and letters.

The Hamilton County Bar Association strives to connect and support attorneys through professional development, networking contacts, and educational resources. It dates from c. 1890, and is still in operation today.

The Indianapolis Bar Association was founded in 1878 by a group of Indianapolis attorneys and is still in operation today. Their goal is to exchange ideas, promote justice, and establish a social network of individuals in the legal profession.
